In a survey by Harvard Graduate School of Education's Making Caring Common (MCC) project, more than three-quarters of adults surveyed highlighted the following as ways to combat loneliness:

- Reaching out to family or friends
- Learning to love oneself
- Learning to be more forgiving of others
- Finding ways to help others



According to a survey of Americans conducted online by The Harris Poll on behalf of the American Psychological Association, 54 percent of American adults feel isolated. Those who reported experiencing high levels of loneliness also reported feeling:

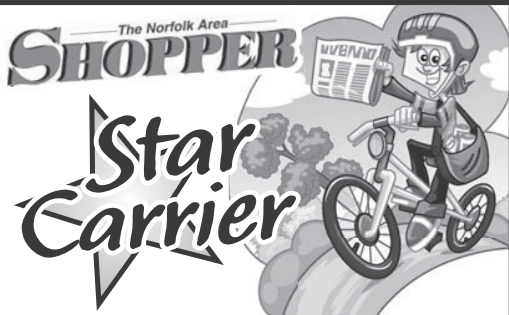
